Joe Horaney was present to provide the City with updated pricing/info at Linn County Solid Waste Agency. There will be no tipping fee changes in FY2020. TV/monitor recycling fee will increase to \$15 per unit. Residents are reminded to make sure items for recycling are cleaned and rinsed.

Wish list of watershed projects were discussed as follows: Big Creek Road bridge repairs; runoff on Ely Street and Skylark; culvert repairs/replacement; storm drainage; water engineering survey; raising Ely St from railroad tracks to bridge; raise road over creek at 1304 Bertram St.

Rosels have been working on getting feral cats spayed or neutered. To date, 24 cats have been fixed. McBurney made motion to reimburse Craig Rosel \$500.00 to cover some of the cost of the spaying/neutering process in July 2019. MSB Carpenter. None opposed, motion carried.

Street repair/maintenance projects discussed: Timberlake, Echo Lake, Knapp Road, Hilltop resurfacing (scheduled for this spring); culvert at 1226 2nd Street; crack sealing; street cleaning; striping of main road through town. Mayor Mulholland to contact Kluesner for estimates.

FEMA reimbursement is stalled pending an archaeological survey. Malone received only one estimate for said survey from Impact7G, Inc., for \$3,800.00, and they can complete the survey in April. We risk losing remaining FEMA funding if we wait too long to complete this step. Malone made motion to accept the Impact7G, Inc., bid for \$3,800.00. MSB Price. None opposed, motion carried.

Alliant Energy will be moving electrical lines underground in Rustic Ridge. Disc golf players will reimburse City for signage on the holes. Mulholland and Malone to review driveway proposal at 1235 Bertram St. Condolences go out to the Mildred Robinson and Marla Rosel families as they grieve the loss of these long-time residents.

Hunt made motion to adjourn. MSB Malone. None opposed, meeting adjourned at 8:20 PM.
