Motion by Wilson to table resolution to vacate Deer Trail Right of Way to determine start and end points to ensure it doesn't impact ability for other residents to access property. MSB Morahan. Ayes: Carpenter, Morahan, Mulholland, Price, Wilson. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Land Use Plan Update: Carpenter to connect with ECICOG to begin gathering public input to proceed with this project beginning in December.

Park Update: Four Oaks has received the grant money from UPRR. City to pay any related bills and submit to Four Oaks for reimbursement from the grant fund. Wilson to continue to reach out to contractors for estimates.

Aug 10 Derecho Storm Updates:

- Mayor Hunt and Carpenter met with structural engineer to review City Hall and attached shop. There is sheeting broken above City Hall, and
  recommendation for shop is to tear off shingles and remove sheeting to view structure. Pavilion at City Park appeared to be salvageable and is not
  a total loss.
- Insurance has \$100K set aside for building repairs and \$50K on trees. We will still need estimate of shingles for pavilion.
- Commercial flagpole estimate has been received: \$3900.00.
- A crack in asphalt parking lot has been discovered at City Park.
- Hilltop Road had a tree limb fall on it during debris removal causing a crack. Contractor should be responsible for this repair.
- Need to discuss with FEMA removal of remaining trees near city well house.
- Do not yet have an update on grinding and debris removal from drop sites.
- County is asking if we have any signs damaged per our 28E agreement on shared roads.
- Restroom building cracks appear to be due to settling and not storm damage.

Correspondence:

- Cummins has recommended battery replacement on the generator. They can install next year to avoid an extra service call.
- Colony Heating to check the furnace at City Hall in mid-November. They will also look at the AC unit that appears to have storm damage.
- Potential infestation of carpenter ants or termites. Mayor Hunt has notified Quality Pest Control to try and get a consult.
- Price would like to add to the website that planning and zoning information must be submitted by the second Tuesday of the month in order to have it ready for P&Z Committee to review.
