Margy Wilson was sworn in as Mayor by the City Clerk for her term beginning Jan. 1, 2022. Incoming Council Members Steve Carpenter, Louise Hall, John Klimek, Chris Price and Jim Unzeitig by the City Clerk for their terms beginning Jan. 1, 2022.

Carpenter made motion to hire Cal Vaughn for the open Public Works position. MSB Wilson. Motion approved by unanimous vote.

Wilson made motion to adopt Resolution R-17-2021 Setting Wages/Salaries for Appointed Officers and Hourly Employees of the City of Bertram, Iowa Effective Dec. 1, 2021, in order to recruit and retain employees. MSB Mulholland. Roll call vote: Mulholland-Aye; Carpenter-Aye; Wilson-Aye; Price-Aye; Unzeitig-Aye. Wages updated as follows: Lisa Berry (Clerk) - \$425.00/month, no change. Cal Vaughn (General Public Works) - \$25.00/hour; Sheldon King (General Public Works) - \$26.00/hour; Doug Kula (General Public Works) - \$26.00/hour; Tony Vislisel (General Public Works) - \$26.00/hour; Brad Vislisel (Seasonal Public Works) - \$16.50/hour.

Wilson made motion to purchase a 1,000-gallon tank from Linn Co-Op for \$4,375, first and second stage regulators for \$100 each, and a cost of \$4.00/foot to trench a line (if needed) for the pump house. MSB Carpenter. Motion approved by unanimous vote. Price made motion to fill the new tank up to 500

gallons when we get it, and then fill it in the spring when rates come down. MSB Carpenter. Motion approved by unanimous vote. Upgrade of the LP tank at the pump house is for future hazard mitigation.

Carpenter made motion to accept Country Arborists quote of \$1,320.00 to remove hangers in large oak tree on Skyline Road to lower development. MSB Wilson. Motion approved by unanimous vote.

Price made motion to accept Country Arborists quotes of \$4,132.50 to remove five trees inside the fence at the pump house (with fence removed) and \$5,940 to remove four large oaks outside the fence. MSB Wilson. Motion approved by unanimous vote.

No new quotes for pump house fence replacement. Unzeitig to work on three new quotes. Insurance is waiting for the invoice for this to close out our claim.

Unzeitig confirmed with WT Group that there are no other ADA compliance projects in the area that we could partner with. Wilson and Price met with Hall and Hall Engineering who has also done some ADA compliance projects. Wilson to request additional quotes for the project.

Carpenter and City Clerk to work on investment options week of Dec. 14.

Carpenter read a special resolution thanking Mayor Hunt and Council member Mulholland for their service to the community. They have accomplished many projects to better the community.

Price: Blue truck has been repaired and should be ready for snow removal. Red truck is also ready for snow. He is discussing natural gas expansion with Mid American, as well as checking on replacement of local option tax on Alliant and Mid American utility bills with a franchise tax. The City would receive 100% of franchise fee collections whereas we currently receive a fraction of LOST collections. Both Alliant and Mid American will pay for publication fees.
