McBurney made motion that the City proceed with enacting an ordinance to restrict fireworks usage within City limits to the following dates/times: July 1-3 (9:00 pm – 10:00 pm), July 4 (9:00 pm to 11:00 pm), December 31 (6:00 pm to 1:00 am). MSB Carpenter. None opposed, motion carried. Clerk to work on a draft for Council and attorney review.

A few citizens (both inside and outside city limits) have expressed concerns over the increased activity and police presence at Four Oaks. Council to reach out to Four Oaks officials to make them aware of citizens' concerns.

McBurney made motion to accept LP contract with Linn Co-Op Oil Company at \$1.28 per gallon for 1,000 gallons. Total contract amount is \$1,280.00 less balance carryover from prior year of \$225.00 for net amount due of \$1,055.00. MSB Hunt. None opposed, motion carried.

Soil & Water conservation will complete an analysis of water flow in town once they get updated elevation information from VJ Engineering. Mediacom rates are increasing.

Carpenter has been talking to Green America to analyze the City's high & low places to determine different methods of mitigating run off.

Mayor Drahos will officially resign his position effected August 3rd due to the sale of his residence and relocation to a property outside of city limits. He will continue his position on the board of the Lower Cedar WMA.

Houghtaling to proceed with snow plow equipment install on the new truck by end of August.

200 Angle Street roof is complete but there are different colored shingles on the front of the house. Resident's attorney assured the Council at the July meeting these shingles would all be the same color. City to consult with attorney.

Council to review existing ordinances to determine if there are any that apply specifically to noise and whether or not quiet times have been set.

Hunt made motion to adjourn. MSB McBurney. None opposed, meeting adjourned at 8:39 PM.
